These are only suggested amounts. The quantity of food your dog needs to maintain optimum nutrition depends on activity, age, disposition & environment. Increase feeding for pregnant females until they are receiving 50% more food during the last 3 weeks of pregnancy. Nursing females should be fed 2-3x more food than they would normally receive. Puppies require about twice as much as adult dogs & should be fed three to four times daily until six months old, then twice daily until nine months to one year old. When introducing a new food to your dog it is important to do so slowly. For the first few days, feed 10% of the new food mixed with 90% of the food the dog has been eating.

By introducing new food to your dog this way over several weeks you should be able to avoid any canine digestive upset.
